Test report: ELAC Debut Reference DBR62

On January 31, 2020, the Kiel-based company informed us in a press release that the new ELAC Debut Reference series will be available from February 2020 with the following slogan "A classic of tomorrow." Reference series tested. A loudspeaker that shines with new, coordinated components.

Structure of the ELAC DBR62 bookshelf speakers

The Bookshelf Speaker DBR62 is a 2-way bass reflex passive speaker that builds on the previous model series. The engineers at ELAC installed new, coordinated components in the Debut Reference series. A 25 mm fabric dome is used as the tweeter. The woofer is equipped with an aramid fiber reinforced membrane with a diameter of 165 mm. The bass reflex opening is located on the front of the speaker and the connection terminals are made of metal on the back of the bookshelf speaker. The housing is made of MDF and the speaker has a weight of approx. 8.2 kg.

Design and positioning of the ELAC Debut Reference DBR62

The DBR62 bookshelf speaker is available in two colors - oak / white and walnut / black. Our test device shines in walnut veneer with a black front look. The veneer on the housing and the paint on the front of the speaker are neatly processed and give the DBR62 a nice feel. The tweeters have a very sporty look and, according to our taste, match the speaker perfectly. The woofers and the bass reflex opening complete the picture of the elegant loudspeaker. The scope of delivery includes loudspeaker grilles that fit the loudspeaker optically well. The terminals on the back are of high quality, have a nice feel and the speaker cables can be screwed together. The dimensions of this bookshelf speaker fit perfectly into a bookshelf.
